RoHS Policy Statement

Directive 2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment, and The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012 ("RoHS") [SI 2012/3032("RoHS")]

In accordance with environmental guidelines set forth by the European Union in 2006, Roscan Electronics Ltd adopts environmental policy in accordance with the RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) Directive 2011/65/EU, which prohibits the inclusion of the following substances in electronic devices or Printed Circuit Boards:

Lead (Pb) < 0.1%
Mercury (Hg) < 0.1%
Cadmium (Cd) < 0.01%
Hexavalent Chromium (CrVI) < 0.1%
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) < 0.1%
Polybrominated Diphenyl Esters (PBDE) < 0.1%

- Where (customer's) lawful exclusions are in place, Roscan Electronics Ltd. can continue to provide lead-based solder products.
